

Re-opening Plan for Worship

The Governor has lifted the advisory and we are cleared to gather for Sunday worship. We will do so with the following measures. However, if you are uncomfortable about gathering in person for worship, please do not feel pressure to attend. Stay home. We will be hoping to livestream on our [new website](#) and or [YouTube Live](#) at 10:30 am.

- We are asking all those attendees with underlying at risk health conditions (diabetes, asthma, high blood pressure etc.) to remain at home until the risk has abated.
- Advise no one 70 or over to attend, if they have a pre-existing condition.
- If you are not feeling well, running a fever (100.4 or higher) or have a cough, please stay at home.
- People seating by family groups. Their children are welcome in the sanctuary. We'll tolerate the noise. There will not be children's education at this point.
- Masks mandatory for everyone in attendance. Please bring your mask!
- Adult Education re-starting 1 month later.
- No nursery, except for diaper changing only.
- When Greeting each other at F.B.C. please do not shake hands or hug and make sure you maintain six feet of distance.
- [No coffee](#) will be available before worship. Please feel free to bring your own coffee from home.
- We will not be handing out bulletins/worship guides but will lead worshippers via the video screen and power-point.
- At approximately 10:15, we will admit people into the sanctuary by family or as single individuals. Please utilize the hand sanitizer provided for you at the entrance.

- Seating will be in clusters and arranged by family and individuals. This seating arrangement will remain the same week by week to minimize any risk.
- Upon completion of the service, we will dismiss you by group for fellowship on the side lawn (or parking lot). Please again utilize the hand sanitizer at the door on your way out. And keep your social distancing to 6 ft.

We will be cleaning the sanctuary and high touch spots before each worship service to ensure safety.

- Cleaning is about removing contaminants from a surface.
- Disinfecting is about killing pathogens.
- Doing both is helpful to decrease risk.

Seating arrangements for Sunday, the first Sunday back at F.B.C. will be marked on the pews in the sanctuary – you can select a spot when you enter the sanctuary – ushers will assist in guiding you.
